1. **Project team, especially the lead architect, they wanted to find out the type of certificate required. No specific certificate as such but the certificate must be related to the defining, developing and implementing EA. For example:**
 - ✓ Open Group Architecture Framework (TOGAF)
 - ✓ Certified IT Architect (CITA)
 - ✓ Enterprise Architecture Center of Excellence (EACOE)
 - ✓ Certified SOA Architect service-oriented architectures (SOAs),
 - ✓ The Zachman Certified - Enterprise Architect Program
 - ✓ Red Hat Certified Architect (RHCA)
 - ✓ Enterprise and Solution Architecture Practitioner
